Each stage of the program prepares students for GSE and CASEL test taking in addition to real-life industry situations. The foundation of our program is built on self-confidence, self-motivation, and self-discipline as an individual. Students begin with learning the fundamentals of performing, industry etiquette, and the production process. As they progress through the program, we look to expose each student to multiple roles (e.g. writing, acting, video, sound, lighting, set design, and camera work) while honing in on their talents, gifts and passions. We bring it all together at the end of the course with an exciting, collaborative, full-scale short film where students learn hands-on techniques and experience. The best films will be screened at the end of year Georgia Student Film Festival powered by Acting Up!

THINK

As students watch various productions they've seen in movies, on YouTube, and other media platforms, they begin the *think* about things they liked or didn't like as well as things that they would do different. As they move through the program, students will have the opportunity to apply those thoughts and focus on the production role that resonates with them most.

Students will have the opportunity to learn how various industry professionals use creativity, technique and focus to

accomplish their artistic goals. By applying these learned principles, students are able to *see* their progression through their completed projects.

FEEL

Students are provided with a medium to express their creative views and expressions. With the guidance of our trained instructors, students *feel* a sense of purpose and achievement with the completion of the program objectives as well as their own productions.

HEAR

Students are motivated by words of encouragement, constructive criticism, and forward-thinking. Throughout the course, students will *hear* compliments, positive feedback, and areas of growth to increase self-confidence and goal-orientation.






Our program is built on hands-on experience, interaction, and collaboration. Acting Up's lectures and exercises give students practical experience in all areas of the acting and film industry.

HOW TO IMPLEMENT ACTING UP INTO YOUR SCHOOL!

THE PROCESS IS SIMPLE AND COST EFFECTIVE TO IMPLEMENT ACTING UP'S PROGRAM INTO THE SCHOOL'S CURRENT CURRICULUM.

- THE SCHOOL IS ASSIGNED A PROGRAM DIRECTOR. YOUR PROGRAM DIRECTOR (DP)
 WILL FIND OUT YOUR INITIAL NEEDS AND MODIFY YOUR PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE
 TO SELECTING KIDS, TIME, AND BUDGET. THE PD WILL ALSO PROVIDE ANY
 INSURANCE OR PAPERWORK NEEDED.
- EACH TEAM CONSISTS OF ONE PROFESSIONAL ACTOR/DIRECTOR AND A PRODUCTION EXPERT. EACH TEAM MEMBER IS QUALIFIED AND HAS UNDERGONE A FULL BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION.
- YOUR PD WILL BE SURE TO LAUNCH YOUR PROGRAM SUCCESSFULLY BY FOLLOWING UP WITH FACULTY, STUDENTS, PARENTS, AND TEAMS THROUGHOUT THE PROGRAM.

PROGRAM CHOICES

Program	Time	Students	Cost	Description
Acting	4 Weeks 3x a week 1-3hr sessions	10-25	\$1000	Preferably in a after school Students focus on Acting Techniques and present scenes to parents, teachers and friends.
Film Production	4 Weeks 3x a week 1-3hr sessions	10-25	\$1500	Preferably in a afterschool Production classes consists of hands on filming experience, learning, and practicing real-world production techniques. Students will film short films and present to class.
Acting and Film	12 Weeks 3x a week 1-3hr sessions	10-25	\$3200	This is a full course that teaches students the ins and outs of film production. Acting and Production techniques are used to create student-made films. The films are presented to family, faculty and students.
Acting Workshop	2-6 Hours	5-30	\$350	A fast pace introduction workshop to Acting, self-motivation, and purpose.
Production Workshop	2-6 Hours	5-15	\$500	A fast pace introduction workshop to Filmmaking, collaboration, and leadership skills.
